With Chrysler's recent bankruptcy filing and restructuring plans we want to update you on the communication we've received thus far. As you know, they have stated that they are committed to coming out of bankruptcy in 30-60 days a new, stronger company. Chrysler has, however, assured us that business should continue as usual at the dealership level. Sales, service, and warranty claims, as well as rebates and incentives, should not be affected.

Regarding our inventory here at Braun, we have a good supply of 2008 Dodge/Chrysler vans to meet your needs. And, with Chrysler's current incentives and our "Bloomin' Deals" promotion, new vans are more attractive than ever. We are, of course, working with Chrysler to address our supply needs for the coming months. With all Chrysler plants and some suppliers being idle for up to 60 days, this could potentially create some lead time issues for retail sold units. Thus we'll stay on top of the situation and keep you informed on a regular basis.
